Position & Responsibilities

Role Summary

Volunteer will assist staff in serving meals to individuals and families living at Tubman's shelter for victims/survivors of domestic violence. The shelter is located at Tubman East in Maplewood.

Impact & Benefits

- Contribute to a positive and respectful living experience for families in shelter
- Assist in providing a safe and healthy living environment

Position Responsibilities

- Serve meals in the shelter dining room
- Assist with clean up as needed
- Build positive, safe, and friendly connections with residents
- Communicate concerns to staff as needed

Qualifications & Expectations

Position Qualifications

- Friendly, supportive, mature, and reliable
- Ability to maintain confidentiality, appropriate boundaries, and have good judgment in unexpected situations
- Understand and work from the agency's set of values and philosophical approaches, including trauma-informed and strength-based care
- Ability to engage with a diverse group of clients and team members with a demonstrated commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Must be 16 and older

Time Commitment & Availability

- One consistent 2 hour shift each week preferred (with some flexibility). Shift options – 11:30 am-1:30 pm or 4:30-6:30 pm any day of the week

Supervision & Training

- Attend Tubman's Volunteer/Intern Orientation and Trainings
- Supervised by Shelter staff
